4.A. Harlandale ISD SB1882 Contract – Frank Tejada BEYOND Academy

The Board approved the execution of the Performance Contract between the District and the Texas A&M University–San Antonio Institute for School and Community Partnerships (ISCP) to operate the **Frank M. Tejada BEYOND Academy**, an innovative school model designed to expand equitable access to high-quality, future-focused learning opportunities. The contract outlines ISCP's role as the operating partner responsible for school design implementation, academic program development, staffing support, performance monitoring, and continuous improvement aligned to district and state accountability expectations. The agreement formalizes shared goals for student

achievement, workforce readiness, and personalized pathways, while establishing performance benchmarks, reporting requirements, and governance structures to ensure strong oversight and measurable outcomes.

4.B. San Antonio ISD SB1882 Contract – Young Men’s Leadership Academy

The San Antonio ISD Board of Trustees approved the Institute for School and Community Partnerships (ISCP) at Texas A&M University–San Antonio as the SB1882 Operating Partner for the Young Men’s Leadership Academy, LEAD, a reenvisioned 6th–12th grade college preparatory campus. The partnership will support implementation of a leadership-focused academic model centered on literacy across content areas, project-based and experiential learning, civic engagement, social-emotional development, and expanded access to Advanced Placement, dual credit, and career pathways. The campus design integrates university partnership resources, data-driven continuous improvement practices, and leadership development opportunities to strengthen student outcomes and position the campus to achieve an “A” state accountability rating.

4.C. Contigo Ed Contract – ISCP Intermediary for Texas Postsecondary Pathways Project

Approval of an Unrestricted Subaward Agreement between the Texas A&M University–San Antonio Institute for School and Community Partnerships (ISCP) and Contigo Ed, Inc. (effective January 6, 2026 – September 30, 2028), funded by the Michael & Susan Dell Foundation. The agreement provides up to **\$35,000 in unrestricted funding** for ISCP to serve as the regional intermediary supporting participating school districts in strengthening data-driven advising and improving College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) outcomes through enhanced postsecondary pathways.
