- Early Matters contract with At the Heart of Teaching, Learning & Leadership for the CLASS Coaching and Assessment Pilot
- Early Matters contract with NineYes Marketing for the Early Learning Awareness Campaign and the Childcare Search Tool Awareness, Adoption & Provider Engagement campaign
Approval of a two-year contract with Dam Good Virtual Assistants LLC DBA NineYes Marketing, not to exceed \$700,000, to implement Early Matters San Antonio's Early Learning Awareness Campaign and Childcare Search Tool Awareness, Adoption & Provider Engagement Campaign. The initiative will expand

bilingual early-learning outreach, increase family awareness and use of childcare resources, and strengthen provider participation in the regional childcare search tool across Bexar County.

5.A. June 2026 Board of Directors Meeting Minutes

Approval of the minutes from the June 2026 ISCP Board of Directors meeting as presented. The minutes document the official actions, discussions, and decisions of the Board.

5.B. Frank Tejeda BEYOND Charter School Start Up Grant (CSP) + Harlandale ISD contract, \$363,714

Approval of the \$363,714 professional services agreement between Harlandale ISD and ISCP, funded through the federal Charter Schools Program grant, to support the planning, startup, and initial implementation of Frank M. Tejeda BEYOND Academy. Services include executive and strategic planning, educational model development, operational readiness, student recruitment and enrollment, community partnerships, and professional learning through the 30th instructional day of the 2026–2027 school year.

5.C. NCFL Contract, \$50,000

Acceptance of a \$50,000 grant from the National Center for Families Learning to pilot a multigenerational workforce learning initiative connecting students in grades 6–12 and their families to STEM-related education, workforce development, and credentials of value. ISCP will engage 25 families in the initiative during the 2026–2027 academic year and participate in NCFL training, technical assistance, evaluation, and national dissemination of lessons learned.

5.D. Approval of RFI - Early Childhood Business Coaching Capacity

Approval to release a Request for Information to identify organizations with the capacity to provide business coaching and technical assistance to early childhood providers across San Antonio and Bexar County. The RFI will assess potential partners capable of rapidly deploying three business coaches using the TWC-approved Civitas Business Certification and Curriculum to strengthen provider operations, financial management, enrollment, workforce planning, and long-term sustainability.
