#### Goal 1: Board Superintendent Goal 1: Focus on Student Success

#### **Performance Objective 1: READING**

- Increase the percentage of students meeting Approaches Grade Level Performance on STAAR 3- 5 grade Reading from 50% on the 2022 STAAR to 60% on the 2023 STAAR.
- Increase the percentage of students meeting Meets Grade Level Performance on STAAR 3- 5 grade Reading from 23% to 33%
- Increase the percentage of students meeting Masters Grade Level Performance on STAAR 3-5 grade Reading from 11% to 21%

#### **Performance Objective 2:** EARLY LITERACY

-Increase the end-of-year percentage of students on level in literacy skills for 3rd Grade from 44% in the 2022 STAAR Reading to 54% in the 2023 STAAR.

#### **Performance Objective 3: MATH**

- -Increase the percentage of students meeting Approaches Grade Level Performance on STAAR 3-5 grade Math from 42% in the 2022 STAAR to 52% in the 2023 Math STAAR.
- -Increase the percentage of students meeting Meets Grade Level Performance on STAAR 3-5 grade Math from 15% to 25%.
- -Increase the percentage of students meeting Masters Grade Level Performance on STAAR 3-5 grade Math from 4% to 14%.

#### **Performance Objective 4: SCIENCE**

- Increase the percentage of students meeting Approaches Grade Level Performance on 5th grade Science from 43% on the 2022 STAAR to 53% on the 2023 Science STAAR.
- Increase the percentage of students meeting Meets Grade Level Performance on 5th grade Science STAAR from 13% to 23%.
- Increase the percentage of students meeting Masters Grade Level Performance on 5th grade Science STAAR from 8% to 18%.

Student Achievement: Increase and leverage the use of digital learning activities to promote collaboration, creativity, innovation, integration, and critical thinking application.

#### **Performance Objective 1: SPECIAL EDUCATION**

- -Increase the number of Special Education students meeting the Approaches passing standard on :
- \*Reading STAAR (3-5) from 12% in the 2022 STAAR to 22% in the 2023 STAAR
- \*Math STARR (3-5) from 12% in the 2022 STAAR to 22% in the 2023 STAAR
- \*Science STAAR 5th grade from 3% in the 2022 STAAR to 13% in the 2023 STAAR

**Performance Objective 2:** ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS (BILINGUAL/ESL): Increase the number of English learners students meeting the STAAR Approaches GL standard in grades 3-5 (RDA indicators -formerly PBMAS Indicators).

- Increase English learners performance in Reading STAAR (3-5) from 15% in the 2022 STAAR to 25% in the 2023 STAAR
- Increase English learners performance in Math STAAR (3-5) from 28% in the 2022 STAAR to 38% in the 2023 STAAR
- Increase English learners performance in Science STAAR (5) from 15% in the 2022 STAAR to 25% in the 2023 STAAR
- Increase TELPAS Progress Rate from 27 to 36.

Ensure that identified Priority for Service (PFS) migrant students have the same opportunity to meet the challenging state content and student performance standards expected of all children. 100% of Priority for Service (PFS) migrant students will receive priority access to supplemental instructional and support opportunities.
